



City of Greenville Farmer's Market  
Terms Agreement

1. Produce vendors must be growers within 75 miles of the market and may sell fresh seasonal local and Texas produce. Applicants must agree to a site visit to confirm location and ensure they are growers.
2. Vendors must adhere to all City and State health regulations/licensing including but not limited to the City's Farmer's Market Regulations, Cottage Food Production Operations, Texas Cottage Food Law, Regulations for Samples and obtain a City of Greenville Farmer's Market Health Permit where applicable.
3. A spirit of cooperation among vendors is desired. Market rules and regulations are to be enforced by the City of Greenville Health Sanitarian and/or Main Street Manager only. Any vendor admonishing another vendor may be banned from the Greenville market.
4. All permits, certifications, licensing, sales taxes or other regulations required by State, City or County is the responsibility of the vendor. All necessary permits, certificates and licenses must accompany the application.
5. Vendors are to make application through [www.managemymarket.com](http://www.managemymarket.com). Approved applicants will be charged \$15 per calendar year. Vendors are to update their product list on a regular basis.
6. Vendors will be charged \$10 per space on Saturday Market Days. Stall spaces will be assigned through [www.managemymarket.com](http://www.managemymarket.com). Vendors are responsible for checking weekly prior to market day to know their space assignment. Vendors that are assigned a space and do not arrive may be billed the market fee prior to returning to sell.
7. Saturday Market Days hours are from 8 AM-noon and may vary during different seasons. Vendors may begin setting up one hour prior and may continue to sell after noon. Leave the area free of trash.
8. All tables, chair, displays and signage are the responsibility of the vendor.
9. Hand-crafted items are allowed on the second Saturday of the month.
